Chairman welcomed all the members of the DDC and the following points were discussed in the meeting:

**Item No. 1 : Confirmation of Minutes of last meeting**

**Resolution :** The minutes of last meeting held on 25-02-2022 were comprehended unanimously confirmed. The actions and updates on the previous meeting are:

1. CISCO certification courses on “**CLA: Programming Essentials in C**” module was conducted for II year students and “**CCNA**”, “**Introduction to IOT**”, “**Programming Essentials in Python**” modules and “**ORACLE**” module was also conducted for III year students.
2. Successfully Completed NAAC inspection
3. Guest lectures were organized on Career Guidance, Latest IT Trends
4. Placement oriented training programs were organized for Infosys, TCS-Codevita and Wipro and other companies.
5. Innovative Projects Expo was organized and students exhibited their projects.

**Item No. 2 : NAAC accreditation n with ‘A+’ Grade, CGPA of 3.49 / 4.0**

Chairman happily announced that Institute got NAAC accreditation with ‘A+’ grade, CGPA of 3.49 out of 4.0. Special invitees have congratulated Students, Management and all Stake holders for achieving best grade in first attempt itself. It was also resolved to continue these efforts to strive for autonomous status to the institution.

**Item No. 3 : Conduct of Certification courses, Seminars and Guest lectures with Industry / Academic Experts**

Chairman presented before the members that a total of **172 students** have completed CISCO Certification, NPTEL certification programs. It is proposed to continue certification programs for 2<sup>nd</sup> year and 3<sup>rd</sup> year students. Dr.K.Shahu Chatrapathi and Mr.Prathap Reddy has suggested to encourage students to do more certification programs on cutting edge technologies like Blockchain technology, Python, Amazon web Services from this semester onwards.



**Resolution :** It is resolved to encourage students to do NPTEL, CISCO and other certification programs and make sure at most students will get certified. It also resolved to continue certification programs offered by CISCO, Infosys, Oracle and other eminent organizations.

**Item No. 4 : Conduct of Faculty development programs to enhance faculty skillset**

It is proposed to conduct a one week workshop for faculty on **ERP and its Tools** in the month of September'22. The Proposed course content was verified by experts.

**Item No. 5 : Conduct of International conference and applying for AICTE QIS schemes**

**Item No. 6 : Conduct of Dept. activities - Hackathon, Coding Contests and other events**

The Chairman presented before the members, the list of technical and non-technical events planned for the coming semester. Members suggested to encourage students to participate in coding contests, Hackathons to improve coding skills.

It is also resolved to conduct Coding contests on C, Python and Java under dept. club activities. It is also resolved to conduct workshops on AR/VR Technology, Tableau and other latest trends.



### **Item No. 7 : Placement plans for 2022-23**

The Chairman presented before the committee info on placement and training programs lined up for upcoming semester of AY 2022-23.

**Resolution:** It is resolved to conduct CRT training programs seriously to make sure students will get higher pay packages and better placements.

### **Item No. 8 : Faculty Publications, Research incentives and R&D activity**

Members gone through the faculty publications list and suggested to increase SCI / SCOPUS indexed journal publications. Chairman also presented before the committee about Research incentives given by management. Dr.K.Shahu Chatrapati appreciated management for their initiative and suggested faculty to improve their research outcome.

**Item No. 11: Final year projects, Internships and publications**

Chairman presented before the members that 5 students have successfully completed internship from various companies and also 16 student research papers were published in journals and IEEE conferences. Members expressed satisfaction over number of student publications and also on internships.

**Resolution :** It is resolved to improve quality of projects carried by students by guiding students to work on research papers. It is also resolved to allow all the students to attend internships at companies like CISCO, Informatica and encourage other students to apply for internships.

**Item No. 12 : Professional Electives, Subject Allocation and faculty workload for this semester**

The Chairman explained the process of taking subject options from faculty members and assigning subject accordingly. The Members stressed on need to assign senior faculty members for programming subjects like Programming for Problem Solving, Java Programming subjects. The Chairman has presented before the members about details of faculty recruitment done recently. And also presented Recruitment file before the members. Members stressed on conduct of Faculty Orientation Program for newly recruited faculty members.

**Resolution :** It is resolved to continue the existing PSOs and PEOs without any modifications.



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
