2. Intake progression (Last two years when compared AY 2018-19)

Vignan Institute of Technology and Science (VITS) is located in Hyderabad which is one of top metropolitan cities in Hyderabad and also amidst various world class research organizations, institutions and industries which makes it ideal for having continuous Industry - Institute Interactions. The campus is located 12 km from famous Ramoji Film City. Within a short span the intake has increased. The current intake is 780 for UG, 54 for PG and 8 for lateral entry at second year level with sum total of students.
